

Snake in the Grass by Alan Ayckbourn

This play was first performed at the Stephen Joseph Theatre in Scarborough in 2002 and received rave reviews. It is one of Sir Alan's darker plays although it does have its lighter moments. It is a suspense drama about murder, blackmail and haunting.

Miriam has cared for her father in the family home during his vituperative last years with the help of a creepily polite nurse, Alice. On Father's death, Miriam's older sister, handsome, divorced Annabel, comes home after over twenty years in Tasmania to find that Daddy has left the bulk of his fortune to her. Alice complains to Annabel that Miriam has sacked her and is intent upon blackmail; having evidence, she says, that Miriam did away with the old man. Horrified at the amount of money Alice is demanding, scatty Miriam and tough Annabel decide to join forces against her, but all does not end there!
