Kay Bagshaw 1912-2012

We are very sorry to record the death of Kay Bagshaw aged 100. Kay came to Charing in 1958 when her husband Stanley was appointed headmaster of Charing Primary School. She herself became the school secretary. The Guild was greatly strengthened by its association with the school – our picture shows six Guild members among the staff in 1973.

Kay served the Guild not on stage nor exactly behind the scenes; we depended on her for the preparation of newsletters and programmes (possibly aided by the office Gestetner?) and our records show that she was responsible for the organisation of our Front of House from 1965 to 1990 when she and Stanley became Life Members of the Guild. Sadly, Stanley died towards the end of that year. Kay stayed in Charing for a number of years before moving to Meopham to be closer to her family.

We are glad to remember her wise and loyal friendship.
